# LESSON PLAN INFORMATION

Have you noticed any changes with your plant? Can you see any signs of growth?

Harvest Beets: Can be harvested from the time they're about the size of a golf ball to the size of a tennis ball; larger roots may be tough and woody. Loosen the soil around the beet and gently pull it from the earth.

## **ACTIVITY:**

**Roasted Beets** 

#### Ingredients:

- 2 beets, peeled and thinly sliced
- 1 apple, cut into thin wedges
- 1/2 onion, thinly sliced
- 1 tablespoon honey
- 1 teaspoon lemon juice

#### Method:

- 1. Place the beets, apples, and onions in a large casserole dish.
- 2. In a small bowl, whisk together honey and lemon juice. Pour over the beets, apples, and onion. Mix well.
- 3. Place the casserole dish in a preheated 400 degree oven for 45 minutes.
- 4. Bake until beets are soft and can be pierced with a fork.





### **ACTIVITY: DIY Seed Paper**

Seed paper is a type of hand made paper that includes seeds from different types of plants. The seeds can germinate and sprout when the paper is placed in the soil.
